Before You Leave

- Call credit card and ATM companies to let them know you will be traveling and what countries you will visit. Check credit limits at this time and make sure you have a PIN# that will work abroad.
- Photocopy of passport and itinerary to give to a friend or family member
- Turn down water heater and thermostat
- Arrange for someone to pick up newspaper and mail or place a hold on newspaper and mail delivery
- Put you lights on a timer
- Arrange to board pets
- Confirm flights
